## SUMMARY

Requires training in mental illness recognition prior to obtaining certification as police officer.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT 2 Relating to police officer training; amending ORS 181.641.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 181.641 is amended to read:

- 5 181.641. The Department of Public Safety Standards and Training shall include in the minimum 6 training required for basic certification as a police officer under ORS 181.665:
- 7 (1) The law, theory, policies and practices related to vehicle pursuit driving and, as facilities
- 8 and funding permit, vehicle pursuit training exercises[.]; and
- 9 (2) At least 24 hours of training in the recognition of mental illnesses utilizing a crisis 10 intervention training model.
