SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Housing and Community Services Department and Department of Human Services for Senior Corps programs.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

2 Relating to Senior Corps programs; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
5 **ated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July**
6 **1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____, which may be expended for foster**
7 **grandparent programs and senior companion programs overseen by the Oregon Volunteers**
8 **Commission for Voluntary Action and Service.**

9 **SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
10 **ated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of**
11 **the General Fund, the amount of \$_____, which may be expended for the Retired and Sen-**
12 **ior Volunteer Program established under the Domestic Volunteer Service Act of 1973 (42**
13 **U.S.C. 4950 et seq.).**

14 **SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect**
16 **July 1, 2007.**
