SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Housing and Community Services Department and Department of Human Services for Senior Corps programs.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to Senior Corps programs; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$______, which may be expended for foster grandparent programs and senior companion programs overseen by the Oregon Volunteers Commission for Voluntary Action and Service.
 - SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$______, which may be expended for the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program established under the Domestic Volunteer Service Act of 1973 (42 U.S.C. 4950 et seq.).
 - <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect July 1, 2007.
