House Bill 2799

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Prohibits all district attorneys and deputy district attorneys from engaging in private practice of law.

2 Relating to district attorneys; amending ORS 8.726.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 8.726 is amended to read:

5 8.726. (1) Except as authorized by [subsections (2) and (3) of this section, a district attorney, or a

6 deputy district attorney, who receives an annual salary of more than \$18,000 from the state, or from

7 the state and county, shall] subsection (2) of this section, district attorneys and deputy district

8 attorneys may not engage in the private practice of law.

9 [(2) A district attorney of Gilliam, Sherman, Wallowa or Wheeler County shall be allowed to en-

- 10 gage in the private practice of law, unless the district attorney receives additional compensation from 11 the county under ORS 8.830.]
- 12 [(3)] (2) A district attorney or deputy district attorney may engage in volunteer or pro bono
- 13 legal work [is not prohibited].
