

# House Bill 2799

Sponsored by Representative BARKER

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits all district attorneys and deputy district attorneys from engaging in private practice of law.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to district attorneys; amending ORS 8.726.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 8.726 is amended to read:

5 8.726. (1) Except as authorized by [*subsections (2) and (3) of this section, a district attorney, or a*  
6 *deputy district attorney, who receives an annual salary of more than \$18,000 from the state, or from*  
7 *the state and county, shall*] **subsection (2) of this section, district attorneys and deputy district**  
8 **attorneys may** not engage in the private practice of law.

9 [(2) *A district attorney of Gilliam, Sherman, Wallowa or Wheeler County shall be allowed to en-*  
10 *gage in the private practice of law, unless the district attorney receives additional compensation from*  
11 *the county under ORS 8.830.*]

12 [(3)] **(2) A district attorney or deputy district attorney may engage in** volunteer or pro bono  
13 legal work [*is not prohibited*].
