House Bill 2823

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows state institution of higher education to award post-secondary degree to person ordered to internment camp if certain qualifications are met.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to internment camps. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "internment camp" means a relocation center 4 to which persons were ordered evacuated by Presidential Executive Order 9066, signed on 5 6 February 19, 1942. 7 (2) A person who meets the requirements of subsection (4) of this section may request 8 a state institution of higher education listed in ORS 352.002 to award the person a postsecondary degree. 9

(3) A representative of a deceased person who meets the requirements of subsection (4)
of this section may request a state institution of higher education listed in ORS 352.002 to
award a post-secondary degree on behalf of the deceased person.

(4) Notwithstanding the requirements for a post-secondary degree established by a state
institution of higher education or by the State Board of Higher Education, a state institution
of higher education that receives a request under subsection (2) or (3) of this section may
award a post-secondary degree to a person, or on behalf of a deceased person, who:

17 (a) Was a student at the state institution of higher education in 1942; and

(b) Did not graduate from the institution because the person was ordered to an
internment camp.
