4 "SECTION 5. ORS 680.020 is amended to read:

5 "680.020. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person not otherwise authorized by law to practice 6 dental hygiene or purport to be a dental hygienist without a valid license to practice dental hygiene 7 issued by the Oregon Board of Dentistry.

"(2) The requirements of this section shall not apply to:

9 "(a) Dental hygienists licensed in another state making a clinical presentation sponsored by a 10 bona fide dental or dental hygiene society or association or an accredited dental or dental hygiene 11 education program approved by the board.

12 "(b) Bona fide full-time students of dental hygiene who, during the period of their enrollment and 13 as a part of the course of study in an Oregon dental hygiene education program accredited by the 14 Commission on Dental Accreditation of the American Dental Association, or its successor agency, 15if any, which must have been approved by the board, engage in clinical studies on the premises of 16 such program or in a clinical setting located off the premises if the facility, the instructional staff, 17 and the course of study at the off-premises location meet minimum requirements prescribed by the 18 rules of the board and the clinical study is performed under the direct supervision of a member of 19 the faculty.

20 "(c) Bona fide full-time students of dental hygiene who, during the period of their enrollment and 21as a part of the course of study in a dental hygiene education program located outside of Oregon 22that is accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation of the American Dental Association or its successor agency, engage in community-based or clinical studies as an elective or required 2324 rotation in a clinical setting located in Oregon if the community-based or clinical studies meet 25minimum requirements prescribed by the rules of the board and are performed under the direct supervision of a member of the faculty of the Oregon Health and Science University School of 2627Dentistry or another Oregon university with an accredited dental hygiene education program ap-28proved by the board.

"(d) Candidates who are preparing for licensure examination to practice dental hygiene and whose application has been accepted by the board or its agent, if such clinical preparation is conducted in a clinic located on premises approved for that purpose by the board and if the procedures are limited to examination only.

"(e) Dental hygienists practicing in the discharge of official duties as employees of the United
 States Government and any of its agencies.

35 "(f) Instructors of dental hygiene, whether full- or part-time, while exclusively engaged in

1 teaching activities and while employed in accredited dental hygiene educational programs.

2 "(g) Dental hygienists employed by public health agencies who are not engaged in direct deliv-3 ery of clinical dental hygiene services to patients.

"(h) Counselors and health assistants who have been trained in the application of fluoride
varnishes to the teeth of children and who apply fluoride varnishes only to the teeth of
children enrolled in or receiving services from the Women, Infants and Children Program,
the Oregon prekindergarten program or a federal Head Start grant program.

8 "<u>SECTION 6.</u> Counselors and health assistants who have been trained in the application 9 of fluoride varnishes to the teeth of children may apply fluoride varnishes to the teeth of 10 children enrolled in or receiving services or benefits from the Women, Infants and Children

11 Program, the Oregon prekindergarten program or a federal Head Start grant program.".
