House Bill 2877

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Modifies required findings for Territorial Sea Plan or amendments to Territorial Sea Plan or Oregon Ocean Resources Management Plan. Adds required finding that plans or amendments preserve right of public access to territorial sea.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the territorial sea; amending ORS 196.471.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 196.471 is amended to read:

5 196.471. (1) The Land Conservation and Development Commission shall review the Territorial

6 Sea Plan and any subsequent amendments recommended by the Ocean Policy Advisory Council to

either the Territorial Sea Plan or the Oregon Ocean Resources Management Plan and make findings
that the [plan] plans or amendments:

- 9 (a) Carry out the policies of ORS 196.405 to 196.515; [and]
- (b) Are consistent with applicable statewide planning goals, with emphasis on the four coastal
 goals[.]; and

(c) Preserve the right of public access to the territorial sea.

(2) After making the findings required by subsection (1) of this section, the commission shall
 adopt the Territorial Sea Plan or proposed amendments as part of the Oregon Coastal Management
 Program.

(3) If the commission does not make the findings required by subsection (1) of this section, the commission shall return the plan or amendments to the council for revision. The commission may specify any needed revisions.

(4) Upon adoption of the Territorial Sea Plan or subsequent amendments the commission may,
 after consultation with affected state agencies, identify amendments to agency ocean or coastal re source management programs necessary to conform to the provisions of the adopted plan.
