Requires person to sign acknowledgement and agreement regarding driving while under influence of intoxicants as part of application for driver license or permit.

2	Relating to driving while under the influence of intoxicants.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle
5	Code.
6	SECTION 2. Every applicant for issuance or renewal of a driver license or permit shall
7	sign a statement in substantially the following form:

10	I acknowledge that driving while under the influence of intoxicants can result in serious
11	injury or death. I agree that I will not drive while under the influence of intoxicants.
