SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires person to sign acknowledgement and agreement regarding driving while under influence of intoxicants as part of application for driver license or permit.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to driving while under the influence of intoxicants.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle Code.

SECTION 2. Every applicant for issuance or renewal of a driver license or permit shall sign a statement in substantially the following form:

I acknowledge that driving while under the influence of intoxicants can result in serious injury or death. I agree that I will not drive while under the influence of intoxicants.

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
