

House Bill 2899

Sponsored by Representative BARKER (at the request of Regional Economic Crime Information Center)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Transportation to immediately inform law enforcement if applicant for driver license, driver permit or identification card submits false application.

2 Relating to documents submitted to the Department of Transportation.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle**
5 **Code.**

6 **SECTION 2. Whenever the Department of Transportation has reason to believe that an**
7 **applicant for a driver license, driver permit or identification card issued under ORS 807.400**
8 **has provided a false application in violation of ORS 807.430 or 807.530, the department shall**
9 **immediately notify a law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the offense.**
