House Bill 2925

Sponsored by Representative BOONE, Senator VERGER; Representatives COWAN, KRIEGER, ROBLAN, WITT, Senators JOHNSON, KRUSE, WHITSETT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Exempts certain wave energy projects from certain provisions relating to hydroelectric projects. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to wave energy; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 543.
5	SECTION 2. A wave energy project is exempt from regulation under this chapter, except
6	as provided in ORS 543.050 (3), 543.055 and 543.060 if:
7	(1) The project generates electricity from wave energy;
8	(2) The project is located within Oregon's Territorial Sea, as defined in ORS 196.405;
9	(3) The nominal electric generating capacity, as defined in ORS 469.300, of the project
10	does not exceed five megawatts; and
11	(4) A license under the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. 791a et seq., is not required to either
12	construct or operate the project.
13	SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
14	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect
15	on its passage.
