House Bill 2937

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Department of Veterans' Affairs to provide veterans and health care providers with educational materials on diagnosis, treatment and prevention of hepatitis C.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2	Relating to hepatitis C.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "veteran" means a person who is a resident of
5	Oregon and who served in the Armed Forces of the United States or the Reserves.
6	(2) The Department of Veterans' Affairs shall provide, in written or electronic format,
7	educational materials on the diagnosis, treatment and prevention of hepatitis C in veterans
8	who are at high risk of contracting the disease.
9	(3) The department shall make the materials available to all veterans and health care
10	providers.
11	(4) The materials shall include:
12	(a) The recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the
13	American Liver Foundation relating to the diagnosis, treatment and prevention of hepatitis
14	C; and
15	(b) Information from other groups that the department believes present reliable infor-
16	mation concerning the increased risk to veterans of contracting hepatitis C.
