

# House Bill 2944

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS AND LABOR

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries, upon request, to determine whether project is public works on which payment of prevailing wage rates is required.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to determination of applicability of prevailing wage rates.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 279C.800 to**  
5 **279C.870.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) The Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries shall, upon the**  
7 **request of a public agency, contractor or worker, make a determination about whether a**  
8 **project or proposed project is or would be a public works on which payment of the prevailing**  
9 **rate of wage is or would be required under ORS 279C.840.**

10 **(2) The requester shall provide the commissioner with information necessary to enable**  
11 **the commissioner to make the determination.**

12 **(3) The commissioner shall make the determination within 15 days after receiving the**  
13 **request or 15 days after the requester has provided the commissioner with the information**  
14 **necessary to enable the commissioner to make the determination, whichever is later.**

15 **(4) The requester or any person adversely affected or aggrieved by the commissioner's**  
16 **determination may institute a proceeding for judicial review of the determination in accord-**  
17 **ance with ORS 183.484.**

18 **(5) The commissioner shall adopt rules establishing the process for requesting and mak-**  
19 **ing the determinations described in this section.**
