House Bill 2946

Sponsored by Representative MAURER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Human Services to authorize pilot programs to test alternative health care delivery systems.

Sunsets December 31, 2010.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to health care delivery system pilot programs.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1. The Legislative Assembly finds that:**

5 (1) An efficient and effective health care system is critical to quality of life in Oregon;

6 (2) Oregon's increasing population is putting a strain on the health care delivery system;

7 (3) For all Oregonians to have access to health care, the delivery system must be ex-8 panded; and

9 (4) Clinical trials using health care provider teams designed to take advantage of 10 decision-supporting software and utilizing lower cost frontline providers should be evaluated 11 as part of Oregon's health care delivery system.

12 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) Subject to funds made available by the Legislative Assembly, the De-13 partment of Human Services shall develop one or more pilot programs to test alternative 14 health care delivery systems. Pilot programs may include, but are not limited to, programs 15 testing advanced information technology applications, including decision supporting software 16 that would allow health care decisions to be made during the first contact with the patient.

17 (2) Technology or other methods tested under subsection (1) of this section shall be 18 evaluated for:

(a) Demonstration of health outcomes that are equal to or better than those the current
delivery system provides;

21 (b) Ease of use by patients and providers;

22 (c) Extent of public acceptance; and

23 (d) The cost of implementation and administration.

(3) The department may adopt rules necessary to implement the provisions of this sec-tion.

26 <u>SECTION 3.</u> The Department of Human Services may apply for, receive and accept 27 grants, gifts and other payments, including property and services, from any governmental 28 or other public or private entity or person and may make arrangements for the use of these 29 receipts, including the undertaking of special studies and other projects relating to health 30 care delivery systems.

31 <u>SECTION 4.</u> The Department of Human Services shall implement pilot programs under
