

# House Bill 2985

Sponsored by Representative CLEM (at the request of James Buntjer)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Adds misdemeanors involving physical injury or deadly weapons to offenses that must be reported to Department of State Police Bureau of Criminal Identification.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to transmission of criminal offender information to state police; amending ORS 181.515.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 181.515 is amended to read:

5 181.515. (1) The following crimes are crimes for which criminal offender information must be  
6 provided:

7 *[(1)]* (a) Any felony;

8 *[(2)]* (b) Any misdemeanor or other offense which involves criminal sexual conduct; *[or]*

9 *[(3)]* (c) Any crime which involves a violation of the Uniform Controlled Substances Act[.]; **or**

10 **(d) A misdemeanor which involves use or attempted use of physical force or threatened**  
11 **use of deadly weapon.**

12 **(2) The offenses to which subsection (1)(d) of this section applies are:**

13 **(a) Assault in the fourth degree;**

14 **(b) Strangulation;**

15 **(c) Disorderly conduct;**

16 **(d) Harassment;**

17 **(e) Pointing firearm at another;**

18 **(f) Unlawful possession of a firearm; and**

19 **(g) Criminal trespass while in possession of a firearm.**
