House Bill 3007

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Public Safety Standards and Training to include, as part of minimum training required for basic certification as police officer, training in crisis intervention, including training in identification of and assistance to persons with mental illness.

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 181.610 to 5 181.712.

6 SECTION 2. The Department of Public Safety Standards and Training shall include in the

7 minimum training required for basic certification as a police officer under ORS 181.665 the

8 law, theory, policies and practices related to crisis intervention, including the identification

9 of and assistance to members of the public with mental illness or who potentially have

10 mental health problems.
