## House Bill 3041

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Allows State Department of Fish and Wildlife to appoint volunteer to act as agent for wildlife management purposes under wildlife laws. Directs department to prescribe duties of agent. Limits authority of agent to act.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to wildlife management.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 496.
- 5 SECTION 2. (1) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife may appoint a volunteer to act as an agent for the department for the purposes of wildlife management under the wildlife laws.
  - (2) The department shall:
    - (a) Make the appointment in written form; and
  - (b) Ensure that the written appointment is available to the public for review at the main office of the department in Salem.
  - (3) Upon appointment of an agent by the department, the department shall prescribe the duties of the agent. The authority of the agent to act shall be limited to the terms set forth in the written appointment under subsection (2) of this section.
