## House Bill 3054

Sponsored by Representative SHIELDS (at the request of Roy Jay, Independent Development Enterprise Alliance)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Authorizes Oregon Department of Administrative Services to fund community-based programs that remove impediments to employment.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to legal impediments to employment; and appropriating money. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-4 ated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July 5 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$600,000, which may be expended for the 6 purposes of carrying out the provisions of section 2 of this 2007 Act. 7 8 SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall, after consulting with the Independent Development Enterprise Alliance, develop and execute a statewide 9 plan to support community-based programs that assist underserved individuals in removing 10 legal impediments to employment by: 11 12 (a) Obtaining or reinstating driver licenses; (b) Setting aside minor criminal convictions; or 13 (c) Creating mechanisms to resolve past-due fines, fees and child support obligations. 14 (2) The department may give preference to programs that: 15 (a) Build constructive relationships between communities and the criminal justice sys-16 17 tem: (b) Promote community service; and 18 (c) Establish monitoring programs that measure results. 19 (3) The department may adopt rules to carry out the provisions of this section. 20
