House Bill 3056

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study effects of transferring persons from prison to county jail for last six months of sentence.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to criminal sentencing.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall conduct a study to determine the financial and penological effects of transferring persons under the legal and physical custody of the Department of Corrections to the county jail, in the county where the person was convicted, for the last six months of the person's term of imprisonment. The commission shall, to the greatest extent possible, conduct the study using commission staff and resources.

(2) The commission shall submit a report to the interim legislative committees with jurisdiction over issues related to criminal sentencing no later than June 30, 2008.
