

House Bill 3056

Sponsored by Representative SHIELDS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study effects of transferring persons from prison to county jail for last six months of sentence.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to criminal sentencing.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall conduct a study to de-**
5 **termine the financial and penological effects of transferring persons under the legal and**
6 **physical custody of the Department of Corrections to the county jail, in the county where**
7 **the person was convicted, for the last six months of the person's term of imprisonment. The**
8 **commission shall, to the greatest extent possible, conduct the study using commission staff**
9 **and resources.**

10 **(2) The commission shall submit a report to the interim legislative committees with ju-**
11 **risdiction over issues related to criminal sentencing no later than June 30, 2008.**
