

**A-Engrossed
House Bill 3067**

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires use of current population data **when using formula** for allocations of certain funds to counties.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to allocations to counties; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) If the Department of Human Services uses a formula for allocating to**
5 **counties moneys described in subsection (3) of this section, and if the formula includes pop-**
6 **ulation as a factor in determining the amount of each allocation, the department shall cal-**
7 **culate the formula annually using the most current population data that is available.**

8 **(2) The department shall use as the source of the population data required by subsection**
9 **(1) of this section the primary population research center that is part of the Oregon Uni-**
10 **versity System.**

11 **(3) Subsection (1) of this section applies to moneys allocated to counties for community**
12 **mental health and addiction services.**

13 **SECTION 2. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
14 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect**
15 **on its passage.**
