

House Bill 3067

Sponsored by Representative WHISNANT; Representative THATCHER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires use of current population data for allocations of certain funds to counties.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to allocations to counties.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if a law allocates or requires**
5 **allocation of state moneys to counties on the basis of population, the populations shall be**
6 **determined once each year using the most current data available from a population research**
7 **center that is part of the Oregon University System.**

8 **(2) Subsection (1) of this section applies to moneys distributed by the State Commission**
9 **on Children and Families and to moneys allocated for the following:**

10 **(a) Mental health;**

11 **(b) Public health; and**

12 **(c) Juvenile justice.**
