## House Bill 3067

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if a law allocates or require
5	allocation of state moneys to counties on the basis of population, the populations shall be
6	determined once each year using the most current data available from a population research
7	center that is part of the Oregon University System.
8	(2) Subsection (1) of this section applies to moneys distributed by the State Commission
9	on Children and Families and to moneys allocated for the following:
10	(a) Mental health;
11	(b) Public health; and
12	(c) Juvenile justice.
