

House Bill 3089

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HEALTH CARE (at the request of Oregon Acupuncture Association)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes persons who have completed certain doctoral programs in acupuncture and Oriental medicine to use title "Doctor of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine."

2 Relating to use of professional title by acupuncturists.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 677.757 to**
5 **677.770.**

6 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding ORS 677.085 (5), a person who has completed a program**
7 **that leads to a doctoral degree in Oriental medicine and acupuncture from a school that has**
8 **federally recognized accreditation may use the words "Doctor of Acupuncture and Oriental**
9 **Medicine" or any abbreviation or combination thereof, or any letters or words of similar**
10 **import in connection with the name of the person, or any trade name in which the person**
11 **is interested, in the conduct of any occupation or profession pertaining to the practice of**
12 **acupuncture.**
