## House Bill 3093

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HEALTH CARE (at the request of Parkinson's Resources of Oregon, United Seniors of Oregon, Oregon State Council for Retired Citizens)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Establishes a bill of rights of residents of long term care facilities.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to long term care facilities.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 441.

5 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The Department of Human Services shall adopt a bill of rights for resi-

dents and patients of long term care facilities, as defined in ORS 442.015. The rules shall be
 applicable to all residents and patients.

8 (2) The rights adopted by the department pursuant to subsection (1) of this section shall 9 be in addition to those rights provided in, or by rule adopted pursuant to, ORS 441.605 and

(3) The following rights shall be included in the bill of rights adopted by the department
 pursuant to subsection (1) of this section:

(a) A resident or patient of a long term care facility shall have the right to receive care
from facility staff trained to provide care that is specific to the resident's or patient's disease
or medical condition;

(b) If a long term care facility has agreed to provide a resident or patient with medical management assistance, the resident or patient shall have the right to obtain assistance from facility staff in administering medication that meets the specific requirements of the resident's or patient's disease or medical condition; and

(c) A resident or patient of a long term care facility shall have the right to receive a
 modified or special diet that meets the specific requirements of the resident's or patient's
 disease or medical condition.
