## House Bill 3101

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HEALTH CARE

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires Department of Human Services to study cost of smoking and other tobacco-related illnesses to public health system in Oregon. Instructs department to report findings to Legislative Assembly and Governor by September 30, 2008.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2	Relating to study of cost of tobacco-related illnesses to public health system.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Human Services shall conduct a study to determine
5	the cost of illnesses related to smoking and other uses of tobacco to the public health system
6	in this state.
7	(2) In conducting the study, the department shall work with the office of the Governor,
8	the Oregon Health and Science University, local public health officers and county health de-
9	partments to gather and evaluate data concerning the impact of smoking on the public
10	health system.

(3) The department shall report the results of the study to the Legislative Assembly, in the manner required by ORS 192.245, and the Governor no later than September 30, 2008.
