## House Bill 3112

Sponsored by Representative FLORES; Representatives BOQUIST, WHISNANT (at the request of Rick Hickey, Oregonians for Immigration Reform)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Department of Education to select school district for pilot program to provide English immersion program to English language learners.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to English language learners; and declaring an emergency.

## Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Education shall select a school district for a pilot program designed for English language learners.
(2) The school district selected by the department shall have, for the 2006-2007 school year:
(a) A large increase in English as a second language students from the 2005-2006 school year;
(b) Eighty percent or more of all English as a second language students who are not proficient in English; and
(c) An average daily membership of 35,000 or more.
(3) The pilot program shall provide an English immersion program to students who are English language learners.
(4) The pilot program shall be conducted during the 2007-2008 and 2008-2009 school years.
(5) The department shall report to the Legislative Assembly about the pilot project prior to February 1, 2009.

SECTION 2. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect on its passage.
