SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires alternative incarceration program participants to authorize release of information prior to release from custody.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to alternative incarceration programs.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Department of Cor-5 rections may not release a person on post-prison supervision under ORS 421.508 (3) unless 6 the person authorizes in writing, the release of information regarding the person's progress

in the program and any future incidents of recidivism for the purpose of conducting research
regarding the effectiveness of the program.

9 (2) The department may adopt rules, consistent with federal law, to carry out the pro-10 visions of subsection (1) of this section.
