

# House Bill 3122

Sponsored by Representative THATCHER; Representatives BARKER, OLSON

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires alternative incarceration program participants to authorize release of information prior to release from custody.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to alternative incarceration programs.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Department of Cor-**  
5 **rections may not release a person on post-prison supervision under ORS 421.508 (3) unless**  
6 **the person authorizes in writing, the release of information regarding the person's progress**  
7 **in the program and any future incidents of recidivism for the purpose of conducting research**  
8 **regarding the effectiveness of the program.**

9 **(2) The department may adopt rules, consistent with federal law, to carry out the pro-**  
10 **visions of subsection (1) of this section.**
