House Bill 3127

SUMMARY

Requires State Department of Agriculture to develop and administer program to educate residents of state regarding pesticide use.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1 2 Relating to pesticides. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 634. 4 SECTION 2. The State Department of Agriculture shall develop and administer a pro-5 gram designed to educate residents of this state on matters relating to the use of pesticides. 6 7 The education program developed under this section may include, but need not be limited to: 8 (1) The identification of pests; 9 (2) Alternatives to the use of pesticides; (3) The selection and use of appropriate pesticides; 10 (4) Proper pesticide application methods; 11 12 (5) Pesticide equipment care and cleaning; and (6) The proper storage and disposal of pesticides. 13 14
