

House Bill 3127

Sponsored by Representative THATCHER (at the request of Kerri Miller)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires State Department of Agriculture to develop and administer program to educate residents of state regarding pesticide use.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to pesticides.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 634.**

5 **SECTION 2. The State Department of Agriculture shall develop and administer a pro-**
6 **gram designed to educate residents of this state on matters relating to the use of pesticides.**
7 **The education program developed under this section may include, but need not be limited to:**

- 8 (1) **The identification of pests;**
9 (2) **Alternatives to the use of pesticides;**
10 (3) **The selection and use of appropriate pesticides;**
11 (4) **Proper pesticide application methods;**
12 (5) **Pesticide equipment care and cleaning; and**
13 (6) **The proper storage and disposal of pesticides.**
