

# House Bill 3148

Sponsored by Representative FLORES; Representatives DALLUM, THATCHER, WHISNANT

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits public school teachers from striking.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to teachers; amending ORS 243.736.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** ORS 243.736 is amended to read:

243.736. (1) It [*shall be*] **is** unlawful for [*any emergency telephone worker, parole and probation officer who supervises adult offenders, police officer, firefighter or guard at a correctional institution or mental hospital*] **the following public employees** to strike or recognize a picket line of a labor organization while in the performance of official duties:

**(a) Emergency telephone worker;**

**(b) Firefighter;**

**(c) Guard at a correctional institution or mental hospital;**

**(d) Parole and probation officer who supervises adult offenders;**

**(e) Police officer; or**

**(f) Teacher employed by a school district.**

(2) As used in this section, "emergency telephone worker" means a person whose official focal duties are receiving information through a 9-1-1 emergency reporting system under ORS 401.710 to 401.816, relaying such information to public or private safety agencies or dispatching emergency equipment or personnel in response to such information.

**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
