House Bill 3195

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs each public post-secondary institution to report on number of veterans who are attending institution.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to veterans who are attending a post-secondary institution. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section: (a) "Public post-secondary institution" means: 5 (A) A community college; 6 (B) A state institution of higher education listed in ORS 352.002; and (C) The Oregon Health and Science University. (b) "Veteran" has the meaning given that term in ORS 408.500. 9 (2) Each public post-secondary institution shall report annually on the number of stu-10 dents who are attending the institution who are veterans. The report shall specify the num-11 ber of veterans in each degree or certificate program offered by the institution. The 12 institutions shall report annually to the Legislative Assembly or, if the Legislative Assembly 13

is not in session, to the interim committees related to education or veterans' affairs.
