House Bill 3219

Sponsored by Representative RICHARDSON

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires sponsors of certain legislative measures to provide statement indicating proposed source of revenue. Requires fiscal and revenue impact statements covering five biennia for certain measures.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to measures presented to the Legislative Assembly.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) The sponsor of every measure introduced in the Legislative Assembly that establishes a new program or increases the scope of an existing program shall submit to the first committee to which the measure is referred a statement indicating the recommended source of revenue for the program. For purposes of this section, the following are sponsors:
 - (a) For bills presession filed by a person or department named in ORS 171.130 (2), the Oregon Department of Administrative Services or the person or department filing the measure;
 - (b) For interim, statutory and session committees of the Legislative Assembly, the chairperson of the committee; and
 - (c) For members of the Legislative Assembly, the chief sponsor of the measure.
 - (2) The Legislative Fiscal Officer shall prepare a fiscal impact statement for each measure that establishes a new program or increases the scope of an existing program and that is reported out of a legislative committee. The statement shall include the projected costs attributable to the measure for the biennium in which the measure takes effect and for the next four biennia.
 - (3) The Legislative Revenue Officer shall prepare a revenue impact statement for each measure that establishes a new program or increases the scope of an existing program, that is reported out of a legislative committee and that could have an impact on state revenues. The statement may be based on the statement submitted to a committee under subsection (1) of this section and shall include the projected revenue impact for the biennium in which a measure takes effect and for the next four biennia.
