

House Bill 3220

Sponsored by Representative KOMP; Representatives BRUUN, ESQUIVEL, HANNA, HOLVEY, MAURER, TOMEI

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs school district to issue health report card for each student.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to student health report card; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Each school district shall issue a health report card for each student who attends school in the district. The card shall be issued twice per school year and given to the parent or guardian of the student. The card shall provide information on:

- (1) The weight of the student;**
- (2) The percentage of body fat of the student; and**
- (3) Healthy lifestyle recommendations.**

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2007 Act first applies to the 2007-2008 school year.

SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect July 1, 2007.
