SUMMARY

Requires Department of Human Services to publish and submit to Legislative Assembly annual report containing list of employers with employees receiving public assistance, including food stamp benefits.

- 2 Relating to reports published by Department of Human Services.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Department of Human Services shall publish annually a report containing a list of employers with employees who:
 - (a) Receive medical assistance under ORS 414.705 to 414.750;
- 7 (b) Are enrolled in the Family Health Insurance Assistance Program established in ORS 735.720 to 735.740;
- 9 (c) Are subsidized members, as defined in ORS 735.750, of the Family Health Insurance 10 Assistance Program;
 - (d) Receive temporary assistance for needy families under ORS 418.035 to 418.172;
 - (e) Receive food stamp benefits under ORS 411.806 to 411.845; or
 - (f) Receive any other public assistance as defined by ORS 411.010.
- 14 (2) The report shall contain the following information:
- 15 (a) The name and address of the employer;
 - (b) The number of employees described in subsection (1) of this section who are employed by the employer;
 - (c) The number of dependents of employees who are receiving a type of public assistance described in subsection (1) of this section; and
 - (d) The costs to the department and to the Office of Private Health Partnerships of providing public assistance benefits to the employees described in subsection (1) of this section and the dependents of those employees.
 - (3) The report may not contain any individually identifiable health information as defined in ORS 192.519.
 - (4) The department, in consultation with the Office of Private Health Partnerships, shall adopt all rules necessary to implement subsections (1) and (2) of this section, including but not limited to obtaining information on employers of applicants for public assistance, including food stamps.
 - (5) By March 1 of each year, the department shall submit the report to the Legislative Assembly in the manner described in ORS 192.245 and post the report on the department's

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(6) The Employment Department shall provide all information to the Department of Human Services that is necessary to produce the report required by this section.
