House Bill 3268

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Allocates lottery funds to Department of Transportation for biennium beginning July 1, 2007, for specified purposes.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to allocation of lottery revenues; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) There is allocated to the Department of Transportation from the Ad-4 $\mathbf{5}$ ministrative Services Economic Development Fund the amount identified in subsection (2) 6 of this section.

7 (2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$35,000,000 is es-8 tablished for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-9 penses by the Department of Transportation from the Administrative Services Economic 10 Development Fund for passenger rail infrastructure projects and passenger rail equipment.

11 (3) The allocation of moneys from the Administrative Services Economic Development 12Fund under this section is subject to the requirements in section 4, Article XV of the Oregon Constitution, for deposit of specified amounts of the net proceeds from the Oregon State 13 14 Lottery into the Education Stability Fund and into the Parks and Natural Resources Fund and shall be made only after satisfaction or payment of: 15

16 (a) Amounts allocated to Westside lottery bonds issued under ORS 391.140 or to the re-17 serves or any refunding related to the Westside lottery bonds in accordance with the priority 18 for allocation and disbursement established by ORS 391.130;

(b) All liens, pledges or other obligations relating to lottery bonds or refunding lottery 19 20 bonds that are due or payable during the biennium beginning July 1, 2007; and

21(c) Amounts required by any other pledges of, or liens on, net proceeds from the Oregon State Lottery. 22

23 SECTION 2. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 24 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect 25July 1, 2007.

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
