SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires Legislative Assembly to fully fund Department of State Police from General Fund revenues.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

3	Whereas the Preamble to the Oregon Constitution declares, in part, that maintaining order is
4	one of the reasons for adopting the Constitution; and
5	Whereas section 1, Article I of the Oregon Constitution, declares, in part, that free governments
6	are instituted for the safety of the people; and
7	Whereas providing for the safety of the people is a core function of government; now, therefore,
8	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
9	SECTION 1. Each biennium, the Legislative Assembly shall ensure that the Department
10	of State Police is fully funded from the General Fund revenues of this state.
11	SECTION 2. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
12	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect
13	July 1, 2007.
