Upon a motion, a court may award \$100 in damages and injunctive and declaratory relief to a prevailing plaintiff in a civil action brought under this subsection."
- 11 In line 33, delete "(7)" and insert "(6)".
- On page 3, delete lines 16 through 25 and insert:
 - "(4) Nothing in this section may be interpreted to authorize expression by students that:
- 14 "(a) Is libelous or slanderous; or
- 15 "(b) Constitutes an unwarranted invasion of privacy.
 - "(5) Any student enrolled in a public institution of higher education may commence a civil action to obtain damages under this subsection and appropriate injunctive or declaratory relief as determined by a court for a violation of subsection (2) of this section, the First Amendment to the United States Constitution or section 8, Article I of the Oregon Constitution. Upon a motion, a court may award \$100 in damages and injunctive and declaratory relief to a prevailing plaintiff in a civil action brought under this subsection."
