

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3279

May 10

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 9 and 10.

2 On page 2, line 7, delete “, feature and” and insert “and feature”.

3 In line 8, delete “advertising”.

4 Delete lines 23 through 32 and insert:

5 “(5) Any student, individually or through the student’s parent or guardian, enrolled in a public
6 high school may commence a civil action to obtain damages under this subsection and appropriate
7 injunctive or declaratory relief as determined by a court for a violation of subsection (2) of this
8 section, the First Amendment to the United States Constitution or section 8, Article I of the Oregon
9 Constitution. Upon a motion, a court may award \$100 in damages and injunctive and declaratory
10 relief to a prevailing plaintiff in a civil action brought under this subsection.”.

11 In line 33, delete “(7)” and insert “(6)”.

12 On page 3, delete lines 16 through 25 and insert:

13 “(4) Nothing in this section may be interpreted to authorize expression by students that:

14 “(a) Is libelous or slanderous; or

15 “(b) Constitutes an unwarranted invasion of privacy.

16 “(5) Any student enrolled in a public institution of higher education may commence a civil
17 action to obtain damages under this subsection and appropriate injunctive or declaratory relief as
18 determined by a court for a violation of subsection (2) of this section, the First Amendment to the
19 United States Constitution or section 8, Article I of the Oregon Constitution. Upon a motion, a court
20 may award \$100 in damages and injunctive and declaratory relief to a prevailing plaintiff in a civil
21 action brought under this subsection.”.
