

House Bill 3280

Sponsored by Representative WITT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Permits school district having population of 300,000 or more persons to procure custodial services from qualified nonprofit agency for disabled individuals. Exempts individuals who are employed by nonprofit agency to perform custodial services for school district from provisions of Custodians' Civil Service Law.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to custodial services in school districts of 300,000 or more persons; and declaring an

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding any provision of ORS 242.310 to 242.640 to the contrary,**
6 **a school district having a population of 300,000 or more persons according to the last federal**
7 **census may, in accordance with ORS 279.835 to 279.855, procure custodial services from a**
8 **qualified nonprofit agency for disabled individuals.**

9 **(2) Individuals who are employed by a qualified nonprofit agency for disabled individuals**
10 **to perform custodial services for a school district as described in subsection (1) of this sec-**
11 **tion are not subject to ORS 242.310 to 242.640.**

12 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2007 Act applies to individuals who are employed by a**
13 **qualified nonprofit agency for disabled individuals to perform custodial services for a school**
14 **district as described in section 1 of this 2007 Act before, on or after the effective date of this**
15 **2007 Act.**

16 **SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
17 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect**
18 **on its passage.**
