## House Bill 3333

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs elected officials and state agencies who provide electronic information to public to provide notice of any electronic tracking feature embedded in electronic communication.

Specifies that information obtained by official or agency through use of electronic tracking feature is exempt from disclosure as public record.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to electronic information.
  - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
    - SECTION 1. (1) If a person elected to public office as defined in ORS 260.005 or an agency of the executive department as defined in ORS 174.112 provides information to the public, at public expense, in an electronic format, the person or agency shall include with the information a notice describing any electronic tracking features contained with or embedded in the information.
    - (2) Information obtained by an elected public official or agency through use of any electronic tracking feature described in subsection (1) of this section is exempt from disclosure as public record under ORS 192.410 to 192.505. This subsection does not apply to electronic mail messages sent to a person elected to public office.
