

House Bill 3352

Sponsored by Representative LIM

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Corrections to take all reasonable steps to have criminal alien transported to birth country to serve remaining sentence.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to alien criminals.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) Upon the request of the family of an alien in the physical and legal cus-**
5 **tody of the Department of Corrections, the department shall contact the Attorney General**
6 **of the United States and take all reasonable steps to ensure that the alien is returned to the**
7 **alien's birth country to serve the remainder of the alien's sentence if:**

8 (a) **The alien is convicted of a crime other than murder or aggravated murder; and**

9 (b) **The victim of the crime for which the alien is convicted does not object.**

10 (2) **As used in this section, "alien" means a person who is a citizen or national of a for-**
11 **foreign country.**

12 (3) **The department may adopt rules necessary to carry out the provisions of this 2007**
13 **Act.**
