## House Bill 3372

## **SUMMARY**

Allows person over 16 years of age to operate motor assisted scooter when person's driving privileges have been suspended or revoked.

2	Relating to motor assisted scooters.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle
5	Code.
6	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person over 16 years of age
7	whose driving privileges have been suspended or revoked may operate a motor assisted
8	scooter, as defined in ORS 801.348, on the highways in this state.
