

# House Bill 3372

Sponsored by Representative SCOTT (at the request of Jason Cox)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows person over 16 years of age to operate motor assisted scooter when person's driving privileges have been suspended or revoked.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to motor assisted scooters.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle**  
5 **Code.**

6 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person over 16 years of age**  
7 **whose driving privileges have been suspended or revoked may operate a motor assisted**  
8 **scooter, as defined in ORS 801.348, on the highways in this state.**
