

House Bill 3384

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS AND LABOR

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes Electrical and Elevator Board to assess costs against license holder when imposing sanctions.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to Electrical and Elevator Board disciplinary proceedings.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 479.510 to 479.945.

SECTION 2. If the Electrical and Elevator Board imposes a penalty or other sanction under ORS 455.125 or 479.995 against a license holder, the board may assess the license holder the costs associated with the taking of the disciplinary action against the license holder, including but not limited to the following:

(1) Fees for the service of a complaint.

(2) Fees for the service of subpoenas.

(3) Recording and transcription fees for depositions and a hearing.

(4) Hearing officer fees.

(5) Witness fees, mileage and other costs of ensuring the attendance of witnesses at the hearing.

(6) Costs for board legal counsel.

SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2007 Act applies to Electrical and Elevator Board proceedings for which the board first sends notice under ORS 183.415 to the license holder on or after the effective date of this 2007 Act.
