SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Establishes Oregon State Police Fund. Requires specified percentages of General Fund and lottery revenues to be put into fund. Continuously appropriates moneys in fund to Department of State Police.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Oregon State Police Fund is established in the State Treasury, separate

5 and distinct from the General Fund. Interest earned by the Oregon State Police Fund shall

6 be credited to the fund. Moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated to the Department

7 of State Police to be expended for carrying out the functions of the department.

8 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) In the budget for each biennium, the Legislative Assembly shall appro-9 priate to the Oregon State Police Fund 1.3 percent of the amount of revenues projected to 10 be received by the General Fund for that biennium.

(2) In the budget for each biennium, the Legislative Assembly shall allocate to the
Oregon State Police Fund 1.3 percent of the net revenues of the Oregon State Lottery
projected to be received for that biennium.

SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect July 1, 2007.
