

House Bill 3428

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires district attorney to investigate residency status of convicted persons. Requires district attorney to take all reasonable steps to transfer custody of convicted aliens to federal government.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to criminal aliens.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) When a person is convicted of a crime, the district attorney shall conduct**
5 **an investigation to determine if the convicted person is present in the United States in vio-**
6 **lation of federal immigration laws.**

7 **(2) If the district attorney has reasonable grounds to believe that the convicted person**
8 **is present in the United States in violation of federal immigration laws, the district attorney**
9 **shall notify United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement of the grounds supporting**
10 **that belief and request the federal agency's assistance in confirming the person's legal sta-**
11 **tus.**

12 **(3) If the federal agency confirms that the convicted person is present in the United**
13 **States in violation of federal immigration laws, the district attorney shall take all reasonable**
14 **steps to ensure that the federal agency takes physical and legal custody of the convicted**
15 **person.**
