

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3436

1 Delete lines 4 through 26 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) If the coordinating body under ORS 195.025 (1) has adopted, within 10**  
3 **years before a city initiates an evaluation or amendment of the city’s urban growth bound-**  
4 **ary, a population forecast as required by ORS 195.036 that no longer provides a 20-year**  
5 **forecast for an urban area, a city may propose a revised 20-year forecast for its urban area**  
6 **by extending the coordinating body’s current urban area forecast to a 20-year period using**  
7 **the same growth trend for the urban area assumed in the coordinating body’s current**  
8 **adopted forecast.**

9 **“(2) If the coordinating body has not adopted a forecast as required by ORS 195.036 or if**  
10 **the current forecast was adopted more than 10 years before the city initiates an evaluation**  
11 **or amendment of the city’s urban growth boundary, a city may propose a 20-year forecast**  
12 **for its urban area by:**

13 **“(a) Basing the proposed forecast on the population forecast prepared by the Office of**  
14 **Economic Analysis for the county for a 20-year period that commences when the city initi-**  
15 **ates the evaluation or amendment of the city’s urban growth boundary; and**

16 **“(b) Assuming that the urban area’s share for the forecasted county population deter-**  
17 **mined in paragraph (a) of this subsection will be the same as the urban area’s current share**  
18 **of the county population based on the most recent certified population estimates from**  
19 **Portland State University and the most recent data for the urban area published by the**  
20 **United States Census Bureau.**

21 **“(3)(a) If the coordinating body does not take action on the city’s proposed forecast for**  
22 **the urban area under subsection (1) or (2) of this section within six months after the city’s**  
23 **written request for adoption of the forecast, the city may adopt the extended forecast if:**

24 **“(A) The city provides notice to the other local governments in the county; and**

25 **“(B) The city includes the adopted forecast in the comprehensive plan, or a document**  
26 **included in the plan by reference, in compliance with the applicable requirements of ORS**  
27 **197.610 to 197.650.**

28 **“(b) If the extended forecast is adopted under paragraph (a) of this subsection consistent**  
29 **with the requirements of subsection (1) or (2) of this section:**

30 **“(A) The forecast is deemed to satisfy the requirements of a statewide land use planning**  
31 **goal relating to urbanization to establish a coordinated 20-year population forecast for the**  
32 **urban area; and**

33 **“(B) The city may rely on the population forecast as an appropriate basis upon which the**  
34 **city and county may conduct the evaluation or amendment of the city’s urban growth**  
35 **boundary.**

1           “(4) The process for establishing a population forecast provided in this section is in ad-  
2           dition to and not in lieu of a process established by goal and rule of the Land Conservation  
3           and Development Commission.”  
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
